Full-time students are required to complete at least 24 credits in order to graduate. 18 out of the 24 credits should be the offered by the Department of Industrial Engineering and Management while the others should be courses offered from other relative departments in the University System of Taiwan and/or foreign universities approved by Taiwan's Ministry of Education. III. Applicants with were non-industrial engineering major in undergraduate program should complete Introduction to Industrial Engineering and Management (MGEM20008) for no credits. The course can be exempt if applicants were able to provide certification that similar courses have been completed during undergraduate years and are approval by professor who offers the course or thesis advisor.
