Minimum Term of Study	<ul> <li>Academic Year 2020</li> <li>The Program admits general and on-job students; the relevant provisions for the period of study are as follows: <ol> <li>The period of study for general students is limited to two to seven years, for on-job students is two to eight years, while the period of study does not include the leave of absence from study.</li> <li>The period of study for direct-entrance Ph.D. students is counted from pursuing a doctoral degree.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Before the start of semester examinations, students for some reason may apply for a leave of absence from study for one semester, one academic year or two academic years. Leave of absence from study can be accumulated up to two academic years. When the time is due and the student cannot return to school because he/she needs</li> </ul>	
	time to conduct medical rehabilitation, he/she can apply for extension and subject to be approved by the consideration of Academic Affairs Committee.	
Minimum Credits	<ul> <li>The Requirements of Graduation Credits are as follows:</li> <li>1. The general and on-job students must complete 12 credits of the Science and Engineering courses before graduation (including at least 9 credits of the Program professional courses).</li> <li>2. Independent Study, Seminar and Colloquium are not counted into graduation credits.</li> </ul>	
Minimum Credits for Direct-Entrance Ph.D.	Direct-entrance Ph.D. students should complete 30 credits before graduation (including credits taken in Master Program, and at least 24 credits of the Program professional courses).	
Curriculum and Regulations	<ol> <li>Colloquium is the each-semester required course for first-year doctoral students.</li> <li>Seminar is the each-semester required elective course for first-year doctoral students.</li> <li>Independent Study is the each-semester required elective course for second-year or higher doctoral students.</li> </ol>	
Notes	<ol> <li>The graduate and doctoral students of the College, in principle, must complete the minimum requirement credits within three years after admission, except for the required subjects and the retaken failed subjects, the repeated elective subjects are not counted into graduation credits.</li> <li>Applicable subjects of graduation credits are recognized by the Teaching and Curriculum Committees of the College, the credits of extra required undergraduate subjects of the related department are not counted into graduation credits.</li> </ol>
