Curriculum and Regulations	All doctoral students must take at least two semesters of Thesis Seminar and complete four prerequisite courses including Economics, Accounting, Statistics, and Management. Students are required to take at least one elective course from each of the six areas selected from the nine professional areas listed in Article V of Policies and Procedures of Ph.D. Program, at least three courses from the methodology-related areas, and three courses at least from their major area of study. In the above required courses, at least three (9 credits) of them need to be the doctoral-level professional courses. All the doctoral-level professional courses offered by NCTU College of Management are accepted by the Department and their credits can be counted as the required PhD-level professional courses. Students are required to fulfill the above coursework requirement before being eligible for the Dissertation Oral Examination. Students can apply to waive the above courses (except the PhD-level professional courses) taken previously before entering the program. They may apply to waive the courses prior to the deadline of the course add-and-drop period in the first semester of entrance. No waived courses can be counted as the credits required for graduation. Application for the above waiving of courses after the deadline will not be accepted. Approval from the Department Chairperson, the PhD Program Committee, or the dissertation advisor is required before taking any courses offered by other departments. Students should take "Individual Study" for at least once every academic year after choosing dissertation advisor except when taking leave for the whole academic year, studying abroad as an exchange student, doing research overseas, or preparing to graduate in the academic year. Upon approval by the Department, international students can take GMBA courses offered by the College of Management or IMBA program to meet the above coursework requirement.
