# Implementation Measures of the Law Program

- I. The Law Program has been established according to the "Guidelines for Establishing Programs for Colleges and Departments" of National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (NYCU). The Program provides bachelor and graduate students the opportunity to study fundamental subjects of law for the purpose of cultivating the students' specialties in this area.
- II.Students of NYCU can apply to this program. NYTU grants certification acknowledging program completion to the students who have successfully finished at least 50 credit hours according to the "Program Course Schedule."
- III. The Institute of Technology Law is the primary provider of the Program's courses.
- IV. . Subject to the approval of the Program's chairman, credits of related courses of law (with certification) may be counted towards the program's credit hours requirement.
- V. Students wishing to take the Program should register with the Institute of Technology Law prior to taking courses in order for the Institute to provide necessary information and guidance.
