應修(應選)課程及符合畢業資格之修課相關規定	一、課程 (一)專題討論與學術研究倫理：在學期間，至少需修滿專題討論四學分與一學期學術研究倫理方得畢業。 (二)本學程必修課程：依當學年度適用之修課規定修讀，需至少選修由指導教授指定之課程 1 門。(不含專題討論) (三)博士班第二年(含)以後，在學期間每學年度均需於下學期舉行一次進度報告，進度報告之口試委員需包含校內指導教授及合作企業或法人代表。 (四)博士班需有兩年為產業實作階段，博士生需至產業或法人單位進行實作研發。 (五)修過相關領域課程，欲申請本學程相近之必修課程免修者，得於入學、轉入學程或逕修讀博士班當學期選課前提出，經由學位學程課程委員會審議，通過得免修。因故逾期再申請者，須經學位學程課程委員會同意。 (六)選修課程以修習本院各系所開設課程為原則，如選外校、外院系所課程，須提出申請並經指導教授同意，始得以列入畢業學分。 (七)非開設予研究生修習之研究所課程，不得計入畢業學分。 (八)所有課程需於修業期限內完成，並通過。

Curriculum and Regulations	Courses: (1) Seminar: at least four credits and one semester of academic research ethics. (2) Compulsory courses: To study in accordance with the applicable course regulations of the current academic year, at least one course designated by the supervisor must be taken. (3) After the second year (inclusive) of the doctoral program, a progress report must be held during each year. The oral examination members must include the professors and industry teacher. (4) The students need to go to the industry two years for implementation internship. (5) Students who have completed relevant courses in related fields and wish to apply for exemption from required courses in this program that are similar in content may submit their application before the course selection deadline of the semester in which they enroll, transfer into the program, or directly enter the doctoral program. The application will be reviewed by the Degree Program Curriculum Committee, and an exemption may be granted upon approval. Applications submitted after the deadline must be approved by the Degree Program Curriculum Committee. (6) As a general principle, elective courses should be selected from the courses offered by the departments within the college. If students wish to take courses from other universities or departments, they must submit an application and obtain approval from their advisor before these courses can be counted toward graduation credits. (7) Courses that are not specifically offered for graduate students can not be counted toward graduation credits. (8) All courses must be completed and passed within the study period.
